Activities

- **Nickels for Nets**
Collect nickels in a jar/bottle sitting in a doll bed and draped with mosquito netting*
Measure the height or length of the 200 nickels required for one
- **Score One for Nets (Strike Down Malaria or Take a Strike Against Malaria** for bowling)
Collect pledges for a game or shoot-outs in a sport using a net (e.g. basketball [*Nothing but Net*], soccer, volleyball, badminton, hockey [?], etc.)
- **Score One Against Malaria** (Played like the basketball shooting game H-O-R-S-E)
Collect pledges; start with M-A-L-A-R-I-A and remove a letter for each basket or goal
- **You Can Fight Malaria**
Collect and recycle aluminum cans to purchase nets
- **Sleep Tight, Don't Let the Mosquitoes Bite**
Cut out "bed" shapes from construction paper; cover with netting* for each \$10 collected
- **Fill Me! Stop Me!**
Construct banks to look like mosquitoes; collect money to purchase bed nets
- **Knots for Nets**
Knotted bracelets made of colorful thread can be sold for \$10 each
- **Name that Mosquito**
Donations provide the chance to name a mosquito mascot; more donations = more chances
- **MoSKIToes**
Older children/youth receive malaria info. to develop skits to perform in VBS, worship, etc.
- **Malaria Dodgeball**
Demonstrates the numerical connection between justice, poverty, and malaria (contact marysimonsonclark@gmail.com)

Activities

- ***Prayer Bites***[Bytes] (can develop) (April 25, 2011: World Malaria Day)
Offer to prayer team, place in newsletter/bulletins as a list, or offer one "bite" at a time
- See activities listed for Children and Youth
- ***Take a Bite Out of Malaria***
Cover a map of Africa* with red map pin* mosquito bites; remove a pin for each \$10 (<http://www.rlcjuneau.com/nothingbutnets.html>)
Also, see the fondue fundraising activity by Augustana, Chicago, on page 5
- ***Change Your TEN into NET—Reverse Malaria's Threat!***
Graphic available (see page 5); can include a challenge to forego purchase of a \$10 item
- ***Cast Your Nets*** (fundraiser or work group project to assemble a reminder token)
Keyring/hook/*pin with tulle* & logo/mosquito (fishing lure?) for Assembly/sale @ (\$10-\$11)
- ***What's Our Net Mileage?***
Post a map of your site & an African site; add netting* per donation to connect the sites
- ***CHANGE now—STOP malaria or Be the Change... Prevent Malari***
Announce ahead to save change for special collections to purchase bed nets
- ***Promoting Health through Malaria Prevention—One Net at a Time***
Phrasing to be supportive of rather than opposed to; post a square of netting for each \$10
- ***Now I lay thee/you down to sleep***
Encourage parents or grandparents to buy bed nets in honor of their children or grandchildren in order to provide other parents' children with nights of safe sleep (prayer on p. 5)

Continued

- ***Bucks for Bites***
Collect dollars for nets; can use visual above for *Take a Bite Out of Malaria*
- ***The time is NOW***
Using a stopwatch/timer indicate the number of deaths due to malaria in a specific amounts of time; sell “seconds, minutes, hours of life;” sell chances to guess “times up”
- ***A Net’s Worth of Security***
At a festival, allow people to pay to keep people in a net for a short time
- ***Vets for Nets***
Have veterans tell their stories of mosquito-borne illnesses and lead net buying campaign
- ***Join the PGA—Praying, Giving, and Advocating to prevent malaria.***
Provide bullet points for prayers, giving (support giving themes), and advocating (MDG #6)
- ***You’re the Key to Containing Malaria***
Give keyrings (see *Casting Nets*) for donations of \$10-\$11
- ***ONE Networthy Letter***
Specific advocacy letter-writing (e.g. in support of UN Millennium Development Goals)

- ***Fashion a World Without Malaria***
At a luncheon, work in teams to design dresses or hats from nets and model them.

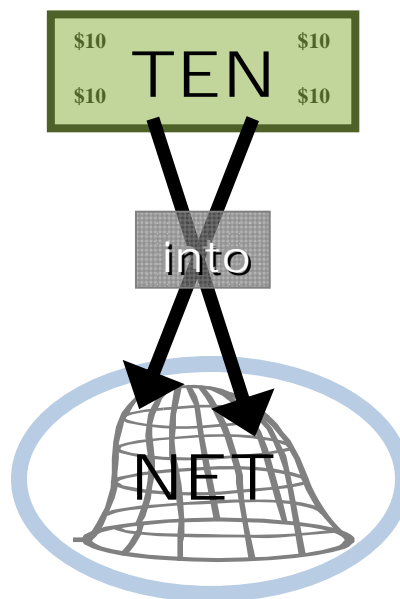
